



Lüderitz Blue School Uniform Policy

1. SCHOOL UNIFORM GUIDE

- i) The wearing of school uniform is compulsory at Lüderitz Blue School.
- ii) School Uniform consists of:
 - School golfer shirt (purchased from School Office)
 - School fleece (purchased from School Office)
 - School hat (purchased from School Office)
 - Choice of skirt, trousers, shorts or skort in navy, grey or black (may be purchased from any clothing store)
 - Uniform is gender neutral and learners may choose from skirt, trousers, shorts or skort
 - Any suitable shoes
- iii) On days where learners attend Sports or outdoor activities, they should wear appropriate shoes for the activity.
- iv) On days where learners have an extra-curricular club with a specific uniform shirt, they may wear this in place of their usual school golfer shirt.

2. DRESS CODE FOR NON-UNIFORM DAYS

- i) The school may organise non-uniform days, for example on days when extracurricular activities require different clothing attire, or on a dress-up day.
- ii) In such cases, learners are encouraged to follow the 3 C's rule: Clean, Comfortable, Covered-up.

3. NOTE FOR STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS

- i) Staff and volunteers at Lüderitz Blue School should follow the 3 C's rule: Clean, Comfortable, Covered-up.
- ii) Staff may wear a Lüderitz Blue School golfer, fleece or staff jacket if desired.

4. NOTE FOR EXTRA-CURRICULAR LEARNERS

- i) Learners joining the extra-curricular programme should follow the 3 C's rule: Clean, Comfortable, Covered-up.
- ii) Appropriate shoes must be worn at all times.

5. NOTE ON JEWELLERY

- i) All jewellery (with the exception of stud earrings) must be removed for Sport lessons or clubs.
- ii) No jewellery (with the exception of earrings) may be worn in school as the school does not accept liability for it.

6. NOTE ON HAIR STYLING

- i) Learners should keep hair away from their eyes and faces.
- ii) If it is past shoulder length, learners are encouraged to tie their hair up to minimise risk of headlice.
- iii) Hair should be brushed and neat.

7. NOTE ON MAKE-UP AND GROOMING PRODUCTS

- i) Nail polish is permitted for learners.
- ii) False or acrylic nails are not permitted for learners.
- iii) Learners are not permitted to wear make-up.
- iv) Learners may wear make-up for special occasions such as a school disco or dress-up day.

8. WEATHER DEPENDENT CLOTHING

- i) In cases of extreme weather such as a heatwave, windstorm or rainstorm, learners must come to school with appropriate clothing (eg. coat, sunhat etc).
