

Lüderitz Blue School Uniform Policy

1. SCHOOL UNIFORM GUIDE

- i) The wearing of school uniform is compulsory at Lüderitz Blue School.
- ii) School Uniform consists of:
 - Primary or Secondary School golfer shirt
 - School fleece
 - School wide-brim hat
 - Choice of bottoms: skirt, trousers, shorts or skort in dark grey or black.
 - Any suitable closed shoes. Please note: clean sneakers are allowed due to the school terrain.
- iii) The golfer shirts, school fleece and wide-brim hats are available to buy from the school office.
- iv) On days where students have an extra-curricular club with a specific uniform shirt, they may wear this in place of their usual school golfer shirt.
- v) The following items are <u>not</u> allowed:
 - tracksuits
 - jeans
 - branded clothing
 - hair dyed unnatural colours
 - jewellery
 - flip flops

2. DRESS CODE FOR NON-UNIFORM DAYS

- i) The school may organise non-uniform days, for example on days when extracurricular activities require different clothing attire, or on a dress-up day.
- ii) In such cases, students are encouraged to follow the 3 C's rule: Clean, Comfortable, Covered-up.
- iii) Clothing must be appropriate for school.

3. NOTE FOR STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS

- i) Staff and volunteers at Lüderitz Blue School should follow the 3 C's rule: Clean, Comfortable, Covered-up.
- ii) Staff may wear a Lüderitz Blue School golfer, fleece or staff jacket if desired.
- iii) For more information on the dress code, staff can refer to the Key Information Pack provided during their onboarding.

4. NOTE FOR EXTRA-CURRICULAR STUDENTS

- i) Students joining the extra-curricular programme should follow the 3 C's rule: Clean, Comfortable, Covered-up.
- ii) Appropriate shoes must be worn at all times.

5. NOTE ON JEWELLERY

- i) No jewellery (with the exception of one set stud earrings) may be worn in school. Additional ear piercings are not allowed.
- ii) The school may not be held liable for the loss of or damage to any jewellery worn at school.

6. NOTE ON HAIR STYLING

- i) Students should keep hair away from their eyes and faces.
- ii) If past shoulder length, students must tie their hair back.
- iii) Hair should be brushed and neat.
- iv) Hair must not be dyed unnatural colours.

7. NOTE ON MAKE-UP AND GROOMING PRODUCTS

- i) Nail polish is not permitted for students.
- ii) False or acrylic nails are not permitted for students.
- iii) Students are not permitted to wear make-up, apart from on special occasions such as a school disco or dress-up day.

8. WEATHER DEPENDENT CLOTHING

i) In cases of extreme weather such as a heatwave, windstorm or rainstorm, students must come to school with appropriate clothing (eg. coat, sunhat etc).
