General Running Costs

The most useful donation to the school would be a contribution towards general running costs to be spent at the school's discretion to cover staffing, utilities, equipment, insurance, stationery - all the things that are less photogenic but are essential to the successful running of the school. Some indications of how a donation might be spent are set out below. Donations of any size are welcome.

Blue School Staffing

The single most important ingredient to the success of a school is its teaching staff.

Existing funding covers the costs of an experienced international teacher and director, one local teacher, one administrator and one extra-curricular coordinator.

Additional funding would allow us to strengthen and expand the teaching staff to cover a broader range of subjects and expertise, including senior primary (grades 6 and 7) from 2024.

Building and Playground Purchase and Renovations

The Lüderitz Blue School currently rents half of a historic building with huge charm, a waterfront location and plenty of scope for expansion.

The owners of the building have agreed to sell it to us at an extremely reasonable price if we can successfully raise funds. They are also happy for us to paint it blue before purchasing.

Tidal Pool and Lifesaver Club

Between 5-10 children drown in Lüderitz every year due to a lack of swimming competency, and a lack of life-saving resources at public beaches. A tidal pool would provide a safe space to run swimming and life-saving lessons. The initial designs have been done and the project is now awaiting approvals from Lüderitz Town Council.
