

Lower Residential Expedition Summary

Overview: This holiday programme invites overseas Lower Secondary School pupils to experience a unique and inspiring learning environment and unforgettable adventure in Namibia's Skeleton Coast - one of the wildest and most remote places on Earth. The 2-week field trip is designed to combine academic learning with adventure, hands-on fieldwork, and unforgettable wildlife encounters. Based in the coastal town of Lüderitz, guest pupils benefit from a bespoke, small-group learning experience that includes exploration of both the local area and some wider regions of Namibia.

Outcomes for Students:

- Observe endemic and rare wildlife
- See vast sand dunes, rugged coastlines, and starlit skies
- Learn hands-on about conservation and the environment.
- Meet like-minded individuals and make new friends

Lüderitz and the surrounding environment: Lüderitz is a special place nestled between two national parks the Namib Naukluft National Park and the Tsau//Khaeb (Sperrgebiet) National Park which are themselves an extension of Namibia's famous Skeleton Coast. Due to the challenges with accessibility, the empty desert landscape

and strict access control, the local ecosystems offer some of the most pristine terrestrial and coastal environments on Earth.

From Lüderitz, there is access to rocky coastline, sandy coves, tidal salt flats and rocky desert. Out of town there is a virtually unique succulent karoo, supporting a high diversity of succulent desert adapted plants, many of which are endemic and estimates suggest that 90% of the invertebrates in this area are unknown to science!

Facilities and activities: Guest pupils enjoy full access to a wide range of ecology-based day trips and wildlife monitoring projects, as well as some broader expedition-style travel throughout Namibia. Activities include desert camping adventures, observing endemic marine wildlife, tracking hyenas, desert exploration and much more.

Students are accommodated in our stunning boarding house and are supported throughout their stay by our experienced and dedicated team. We ensure regular opportunities to contact home, and after each exciting day of activities, there's always something fun happening to keep pupils entertained.

How to Get There: International flights can be taken to Namibia's International Airport (Windhoek Hosea Kutako) From Windhoek we collect pupils and drive them to Luderitz, a wonderful chance to view the picturesque landscapes in the area.
